The MountainHouse Sleep Over

Please return 14 days from receipt

The MountainHouse is a 10,000 square foot mid-mountain facility located near the bottom of chairlifts #3 and #9 and adjacent the Snowtubing Park. It features a food court, huge stone fireplace, ski shop and both male and female shower facilities. At night, we allow groups to use it to SleepOver! Winterplace Ski Resort wants you and your group to have **PURE FUN** while sleeping over at The MountainHouse. Please help us in making your stay enjoyable by carefully reading The MountainHouse Sleep Over procedures. We suggest that you copy this letter for your group members and their families so they will be better informed and know what they can expect during their stay with us. Please make sure your group members are aware that there may be other groups sharing the MountainHouse and we ask that they are respectful of those groups participating in the Sleep Over. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and should be monitored by the group's chaperones. Additionally, MountainHouse Counselors will be available to assist with any groups experiencing such behavior. Our experience has shown that some young children do not manage the Sleep Over well; therefore, children should be at least six to participate in the sleepover.

The **MountainHouse Sleep Over package** includes an air mattress, shower facilities, and a hot, hearty breakfast for only **\$16.95 per person**. For every 15 Sleep Over packages purchased, you will receive one **FREE Sleepover Scholarship**.

Payment and Cancellation Policy

Confirmed number of air mattresses and full lodging payment is due 30 days before your arrival. Winterplace reserves the right to cancel the reservation if payment has not been received. Sleepover additions can possibly be accommodated based on availability at the MountainHouse. Subtractions of reserved sleepovers are permitted only until 14 days before your ski trip. Please see group packet or website for policies concerning skiing/tubing deposits and cancellations. Winterplace does not issue refunds due to factors beyond our control, i.e. weather or snow conditions. Please send the MountainHouse Air Mattress User List 14 days prior to your group's arrival. Any air mattress that is damaged or not turned in to the MountainHouse counselors will be the financial responsibility of the group leader.

Sleepover Check In

Your MountainHouse check in procedures will depend on your arrival time at the MountainHouse. Please speak to a group sales supervisor concerning arrival, unloading gear, and parking. The Sleep Over Counselors will be on site at 10:00pm for your assistance. Before unloading your gear, check in at the retail shop and have the MountainHouse Counselor paged.

Transportation and Parking

Please let us know if you are traveling by motor coach so we can arrange to help you unload your gear. After unloading your gear, you will be asked to move your vans & automobiles to the MountainHouse Parking Lot. Please make sure you park in the appropriate area in case snow removal is necessary.

Gear Storage

Group leaders will be assigned a lockable storage space to store gear. **Group members should be advised to limit their gear to one small bag, sleeping bag, and pillow.** The MountainHouse will open to the public at 8 am and any gear that is left outside of the storage area must be stored in the group's vans or automobiles.

All items should be removed from the storage area and the key returned to the MountainHouse Counselor by 8:00am on the morning of departure. Any keys that are not returned are the financial responsibility of the group leader. ***Please be aware that Winterplace is not responsible for any lost, stole and/or unattended items.***

Group Leader and Chaperon Responsibilities

We recommend that the group member to chaperon ratio be no more than 7 to 1. Group leaders and chaperons are responsible for the behavior of your group members while participating in the Sleep Over. Heavy equipment operates on the slopes during the time the slopes are closed; therefore, Group Leaders and chaperons **MUST** keep group members inside the MountainHouse from 10:00pm until slope opening. If Sleep Over participants are found on the slopes while we are closed, they will be escorted from the slopes and will lose their skiing privileges. No refunds will be given.

Ski Slope Operating Hours

On weekends and holidays, slopes open at 8:00am. On weekdays, slopes open at 9:00am. At 9:30pm chairlifts #3 and #9 close for the night. If your group members are skiing on other slopes, please arrange to transport them to the MountainHouse. Hours of operation may vary during our discount seasons.

Shower Facilities

There are 3 shower facilities in both the men's and women's restrooms. Shower time will be from 10:00pm until 11:30pm each night and lights out will be at 12 midnight. Showering may resume in the morning from 6:00am until 7:30am. Shower necessities are not provided.

Breakfast Hours and Food Court Information

On **weekends and holidays**, breakfast will be served at 7:00am. On **weekdays**, breakfast will be served at 8:00am. The menu consists of Hot cakes, hash browns, scrambled eggs, bacon and juice. No substitutions or exchanges are permitted.

The food courts at Winterplace are licensed restaurants. The use of any cooking devices or food items from other restaurants or vendors is not permitted. Regardless of group size, only 2 coolers or boxes are allowed per group. If utilizing the MountainHouse during the day, coolers and boxes must be kept in our "Cooler Storage Area" before lunchtime and should be put back in that area after they have been used. Please help us keep Winterplace clean by disposing of your trash in the closest trash receptacle and place all aluminum and plastic in the recycling barrels.

Overnight Ski Storage

We recommend that Sleep Over groups utilize the overnight ski storage, which is located off the back deck of the Resort Center. Group members may store skis, snowboards, and poles. The ski/snowboard boots may be stored in vehicles or taken to the MountainHouse with your group. The cost is \$1.00 per person per night.
